Not the June 27, 1938 recording, but from a broadcast transcription (Paradiso Restaurant, New York, April 24, 1938)

2 Sobbin' Blues (Bunny Berigan and His Orchestra) Nov. 22, 1938 (featuring Ray Conniff on trombone)

3 In A Mist (Bunny Berigan and His Orchestra) Nov. 30, 1938 (featuring Ray Conniff on trombone)

4 Little Gate's Special (erroneously titled "Little Fates" on the internet) (Bunny Berigan and His Orchestra) March 15, 1939 (composed by Ray Conniff)

9 Slow 'Em Down Blue's (Art Hodes and His Chicagoans) March 18, 1944

10 **Jumpin' On The Merry-Go-Round** (Artie Shaw And His Orchestra) Nov. 22 or 23, 1944 (not 1947, as stated in the CD booklet) (composed and arranged by Ray Conniff)

11 's Wonderful (Artie Shaw And His Orchestra) January 9, 1945 (arranged by Ray Conniff)

12 If I'm Lucky (Harry James and His Orchestra with Marion Morgan) Note: This is not the recording made on Dec. 21, 1951 (i.e. Ray's arrangement) but the recording with Marion Morgan, recorded August 26, 1946. Ray's arrangement is for orchestra only, as featured on Harry James' album "Soft Lights, Sweet Trumpet".
