








Ray and Vera wed, a double ring ceremony, at the "Little Church of the West", Las Vegas, Nevada, August 24, 1968.

Ray and Vera receiving Ray's award for bringing fame through his music to Ray's home town of Attleboro, Mass.


The award is being presented by Ray's Grammar school music teacher, Mr. John Lang Gibb, 93 years of age and still going strong.

This award was presented on the occasion of Attleboro's 275th Anniversary, October 4, 1969.


